

Virgil Skipper deceased 1985

The Virgil D. Skipper Award was established in 1978, by the Georgia Chapter, ACI, (formerly Atlanta Chapter) to promote the use of ready-mixed concrete. In 1984, the Award program was replaced by the Virgil D. Skipper Memorial Seminar. This seminar is held each year in honor of Mr. Skipper, who passed away in 1985 in the 10th year of his retirement after 30 years of active involvement in the Atlanta concrete industry.

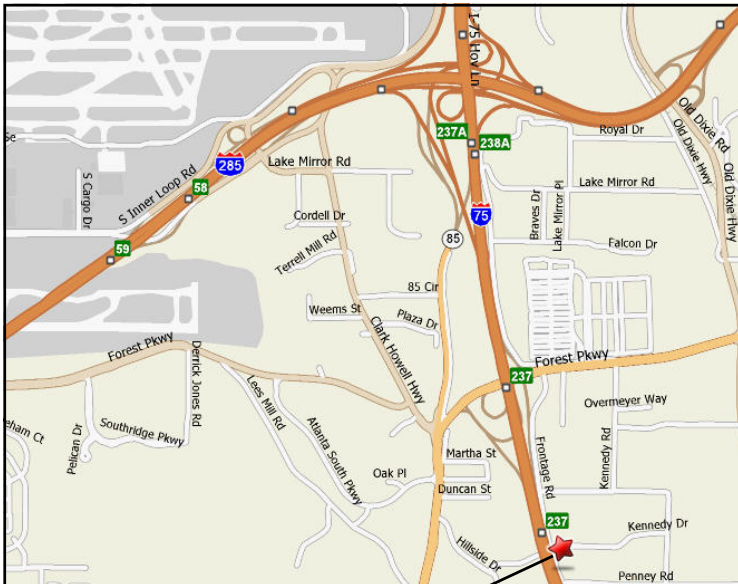
As one of the original organizers of the Georgia Concrete and Products Association, Mr. Skipper was the recipient of several awards from that association

Mr. Skipper also contributed to the establishment of the first Chapter of ACI in Georgia and was instrumental in writing the first specification for ready-mixed concrete which was then used as a model for the ACI 301 "Specifications for Structural Concrete for Buildings". He was a Fellow of the American Concrete Institute and an honorary member of the Atlanta Chapter. It is in keeping with his interests and spirit that the Chapter presents this special program.

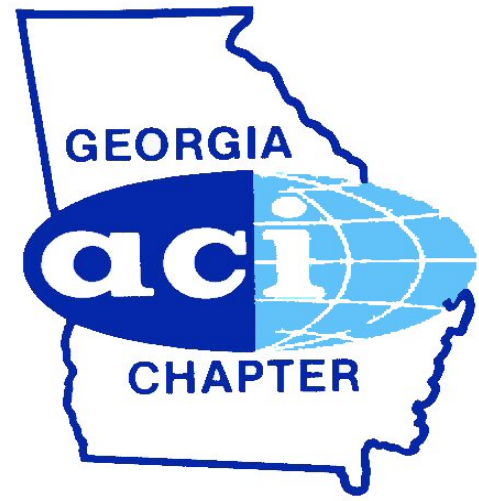


Directions to GDOT's OMR
